Transportation Infrastructure - Federal Aviation Administration

1. Federal/local partnerships: Federal Aviation Administration and WYDOT Aviation Division.
2. A description of the program: Grants-In-Aid for Airports.
For procurement, installation and commissioning of runway incursion prevention devices and systems at airports.
3. Total dollars allocated for the program nationally: \$1.1 billion
4. Total Wyoming dollars: \$0.
5. Eligibility criteria/factors/conditions. Priority given to projects that can be completed within 2 years of enactment and serve to supplement and not supplant planned expenditures from airport-generated revenues or other funding sources.
6. Deadlines for application, for commitment of funds, and duration of the program. Grants totaling not less than 50% of funds available awarded within 120 days of enactment. Grants for funds remaining must be awarded within one year of enactment. Funds remain available through 9/30/10.
