Transportation Infrastructure - Federal Highway Administration

1. Federal/local partnerships: Federal Highway Administration and WYDOT.
2. A description of the program: Highway Infrastructure Investment.  
For restoration, repair, construction, and other activities eligible under the Federal Surface Transportation Program.
3. Total dollars allocated for the program nationally: \$27.5 billion
4. Total Wyoming dollars: \$157.6 million.
5. Eligibility criteria/factors/conditions. Funds can be used for all eligible purposes under the Federal Surface Transportation Program.
6. Deadlines for application, for commitment of funds, and duration of the program. WYDOT has 120 days from 3/2/09 to obligate 50% of funds. Remaining 50% must be obligated in one year from 3/2/09. Note: WYDOT will obligate all funding within 120 days.
7. State budget impacts: 100% Federal funds, no state match required. A project cost overrun could require small amount of state funds if not covered by Federal funds.
8. A breakdown of program funding which is based on formula distribution to states: \$4.7 million set aside for enhancement projects and \$152.9 million distributed by formula.
9. A breakdown of program funding which is based on competitive application from states: All funding is distributed by formula excluding required set aside for enhancements. Potential opportunity exists to apply for additional funding made available through redistribution.
