Transportation Infrastructure - Federal Transit Administration

1. Federal/local partnerships: Federal Transit Administration and WYDOT.
2. A description of the program: Transit Capital Assistance.
3. Total dollars allocated for the program nationally: \$6.7 billion
4. Total Wyoming dollars: \$9.3 million
5. Eligibility criteria/factors/conditions. Funds distributed by formula for Section 5307, 5311, and 5340 transit programs. Funding will be used for buses and bus facilities in local communities.
6. Deadlines for application, for commitment of funds, and duration of the program. FTA to apportion funds not later than 21 days after enactment. A redistribution clause applies to a percentage of funds not obligated in 180 days. Funds remain available through 9/30/10.
7. State budget impacts: None. 100% Federal funds for recipients.
8. A breakdown of program funding which is based on formula distribution to states. Out of the estimated \$9.4 million, Wyoming's program shares are:
 - ✧ Section 5307, Urbanized area formula grants and Section 5340, Apportionments based on growing State and high density States formula factors - \$2.3 million
 - ✧ Section 5311, Formula grants for other than urbanized areas and Section 5340 - \$6.98 million
9. A breakdown of program funding which is based on competitive application from states. All funds distributed by formula.
